On 29 January 2020 two tourists tested positive for COVID-19 in Italy. They were brought to the National Institute for Infectious Diseases in Rome for treatment.




Music in England

INTERVIEW WITH QUEEN ELIZABETH I

A: interviewer

A: Your majesty.

B: Good morning, sir?

A: Valerio Fontana, from Italy.

B: So, Mr Fontana, why are you here?

A: I would like to ask you a few questions.

B: And I would be pleased to answer.

A: First question: what does it feel like to rule a kingdom at just 25 years of age?

B: For me, it was an honour and at the same time a great challenge: the country I inherited was not enjoying a happy time, it was on the verge of social and economic crisis. However, I have always been a determined and clear-minded woman. I have reigned since the first day with great commitment, giving all of myself to my country.

A: I would like to ask your thoughts on the so-called "religious issue". Why did you not tolerate Catholics and send some Puritans into exile, ma'am?

B: The political views of Philip II, the husband of my late sister, and the pontiff were the main reason. It was necessary to protect the nation from those who saw me as an usurper and who wanted my cousin Mary Stuart, a fervent Catholic, on the throne. The Puritans wanted me to transform the English Church radically, eliminating some of its foundations which were part of the compromise with the Roman Catholic Church. England will neither be Catholic nor will be a place ruled by Calvinist fanatics. The Anglican Church was created in a certain way and so will remain in the centuries to come.

A: Was your cousin, Mary Stuart, aware of the plots? Is that the reason why you had her executed?

B: More or less: she proved to be ungrateful. Despite having taken her away from a terrible trial in her Scotland, after she had attacked the life of her own consort, here, in my Kingdom, plotted against my life and my throne so she could take over control.

A: Did you consider yourself a girl like the others, ma'am?

B: In some ways yes, in some ways no. Let me explain: it is not common for my peers to take responsibility for decisions that affect the fate of a nation and millions of people. So, I did not enjoy a carefree life and did not have the common

occupations of women my age. However, I must confess that I enjoyed the pleasures of life: I loved dancing and enjoyed it whenever the opportunity arose. I also fell madly in love twice, but that is not that much of a secret here at court.

A: Now the last question. If you do not want to answer this, I will understand it. What was your relationship with your half-siblings?

B: I felt deeply sorry when my half-brother died. You know, we lived together when we were younger, in Hatfield House. Between 1533 and 1536, my half-sister Mary had to serve me as a punishment for not accepting my father and mother's marriage. My relationship with her was complicated: two different faiths, two different educations, two different women and monarchs. Once, she imprisoned me in the Tower of London, for two months. After that I went back to Hatfield, where I received the news of her death and all the consequences that brought.

A: Well, Your Majesty, I am glad I got to ask you these few questions, it is an honour for me.

B: As it is for me, sir. I wish you good fortune in your life.

A: Thank you, Your Majesty.



Entrevista a Pablo Picasso.

Periodista: señor Picasso, la considero un gran pintor español del siglo XX, pero ¿Cómo empezó todo?

Picasso: Buenas noches y gracias por la invitación, todo empezó gracias a mi padre que era profesor en la Escuela de Bellas Artes de Málaga y desde allí inmediatamente comencé a aprender las técnicas básicas de la pintura.

Periodista: En 1895 se muda con su familia a Barcelona, ¿Qué pasó?

Picasso: Cuando llegué a Barcelona, comencé a familiarizarme con los ambientes artísticos y conocí a poetas, escritores y artistas que luego me llevarán a París.

Periodista: Posteriormente, decidí dividir el éxito en diferentes períodos, ¿Puede contarnos?

Picasso: Sí, decidí dividir diferentes períodos para señalar el proceso de mi trayectoria artística en el período azul, en el período rosa, en el período africano, en el cubismo analítico y en el cubismo sintético. Siempre he sido muy crítico pero con el tiempo mi genio artístico se ha ido comprimiendo por completo, lo que me ha permitido ser reconocido como uno de los más grandes artistas de nuestra civilización.

Periodista: En su opinión, ¿Cuál es el papel del arte?

Picasso: Cuando pinto, mi objetivo es mostrar lo que he encontrado y no lo que estoy buscando. En el arte las intenciones no son suficientes y, como decimos en España, el amor debe probarse con hechos, no con argumentos. Lo que hace cuenta, no lo que intenta hacer.

El arte es una mentira que nos hace darnos cuenta de la verdad. El artista debe saber cómo convencer a los demás de la verdad de sus mentiras.

Periodista: Sabemos que Guernica tiene un valor inestimable. Cuéntanos un poco cuál fue el impulso para crear esta maravilla.

Picasso: En Guernica expreso mi odio por la casta militar que hundió a España en un océano de dolor y muerte. La ridícula mentira que han circulado los propagandistas fascistas ha sido refutada por la gran cantidad de artistas e intelectuales que han visitado España recientemente, y que han reconocido el profundo respeto que el pueblo español en armas ha demostrado al salvar la gran riqueza de cuadros y pinturas, tapices religiosos y de bombas incendiarias fascistas. Todo el mundo conoce el bárbaro bombardeo del Museo del Prado por parte de aviones rebeldes, todo el mundo sabe cómo los soldados consiguieron salvar los tesoros artísticos arriesgando sus vidas.

Periodista: Una cosa que siempre me he preguntado es: ¿No se cansan los pintores de estar de pie mientras pintan?

Picasso: No. Por eso los pintores viven tanto. Yo mientras trabajo dejo mi cuerpo afuera de la puerta; Trabajo todo el día. Cuando la luz del día empieza a disminuir en el lienzo, proyecta dos focos sobre él y todo a su alrededor desaparece en las sombras. La oscuridad debe ser completa en todas partes, excepto en el lienzo, para que el pintor quede hipnotizado por su obra y pinta casi como en trance. Debe permanecer lo más cerrado posible en su mundo interior, si quiere trascender los límites que su razón intenta imponerle. Todo el mundo tiene energía potencial. La persona promede desperdicia la suya en una docena de pequeñas formas. Práctico el mío en una cosa: mis pinturas, y todo lo demás se les sacrifica ... incluyéndome a mí.

Periodista: No quiero detenerme en esta frase suya. Sé que ilustraste el libro que publicó Skira Ovid's Metamorphosides, que también marcó el inicio de la editorial, ¿Verdad?

Picasso: Exacto. ¿Y sabes cómo nació la idea de ese libro? Cuando Skira era joven, desesperaba a su madre porque no quería estudiar. Tenía entonces veintidós o veintitrés años y no parecía importarle nada y su madre, que era viuda, no sabía qué hacer con él. Cansado de que le preguntaba constantemente qué iba a hacer en la vida, le declaró un día que quería ser editor. Sorprendida, ella le preguntó qué publicaría. Para calmarla le respondió: "Estoy a punto de publicar un libro ilustrado por Picasso". Ella no quiso desanimarlo y le aconsejó que viniera a verme. Ese fue el comienzo de Skira.

Periodista: En 1904 regresó a París donde vivió allí muchos años. Conocer a alguien nuevo y de regreso de aquel período de serenidad y tranquilidad que se refleja obviamente en sus cuadros.

Pero, ¿Qué tuvo realmente éxito en su vida?

Picasso: Por supuesto, conocí a Matisse, a quien encantaba el arte africano y la llevé de una manera pura y en perspectiva.

Yo era el Polo Sur, yo era el Polo Norte. La nuestra siempre ha sido una relación de amor y odio. Además el año siguiente entró en el apogeo del cubismo, un movimiento artístico que nació en París hacia 1907, que involucró no solo al mundo del arte, sino también al de la literatura y la música.

Cuando Matisse murió, dejó sus odaliscas en mi legado, y esta es mi idea de Oriente, aunque nunca lo fue. Todo se hace con las intenciones del momento. Entonces, lo que tengo ganas de decir es: no juzgues mal lo que no sabes, aprovechá para entender.

Periodista: Muchas gracias por su tiempo Sr. Picasso, es un verdadero placer hablar con usted. Siempre llevaremos con nosotros una de sus frases más famosas:

"Lo que haces cuenta, no lo que pretendes hacer".

Picasso: Gracias a ti.

Sevilla

¡Bienvenido! ,

Hoy te llevamos a un lugar mágico: Sevilla

Sevilla es una ciudad de España que tiene 1 millón y 950 miles de habitantes.

Está situada en el sur de la península ibérica y es la capital de Andalucía.

Es famosa por el **flamenco**, forma de baile o música, y es una ciudad histórica.

El nombre de la ciudad proviene del nombre indígena tartésico Spal o Ispal, que significa "tierra plana". Tras la conquista, los romanos latinizar el nombre en Hispalis, que en época andaluza cambió a Ishbiliya (árabe أشبيلية), debido a la sustitución de la "p" (fonema inexistente en árabe) por la "b" y de la "a" tónica por "i" (fenómeno característico del árabe hispánico conocido como Imāla), del que deriva la forma actual Sevilla.



★ LA HISTORIA

Sevilla tiene una **historia milenaria**: fundada por los romanos, conquistada por los árabes, alcanza su máximo esplendor en el Siglo de Oro, el período desde el nacimiento del imperio español, que representa el periodo de mayor gloria de España.

Gracias al Guadalquivir, el único río navegable de España que divide la ciudad en dos, Sevilla ha sido siempre un pujante centro comercial, tanto que en el siglo XIV se ganó el sobrenombre de "puerto y puerta de Indias".

Sevilla acogió la Exposición Universal de 1929 y acogió a millones de visitantes para la Expo de 1992. Para estos eventos Sevilla ha experimentado una importante modernización.

Muchos monumentos de Sevilla tienen influencia musulmana, porque en el pasado, ella fue dominio musulmán.

★ MONUMENTOS DE CULTURA MUSULMANA

Un monumento de la cultura musulmana es:
GIRALDA

Nacida como minarete de la mezquita y luego convertida en campanario de la Catedral, la Giralda es el monumento más emblemático y



visitado de Sevilla.

La Giralda se construyó en época musulmana siguiendo el modelo de la Mezquita Koutoubia de Marrakech aunque la parte superior solo se terminó durante la época cristiana. Cuenta la leyenda que cuando los musulmanes fueron derrotados pudieron derribar la torre para que no acabara en manos de los cristianos deseó que impulsó a Alfonso X a mantenerla como símbolo de una etapa importante de la historia de la ciudad.

En España hay otros muchos monumentos importantes como:

★ EL ALCÁZAR

El **Alcázar de Sevilla** es un palacio real español, que ha sido ampliado varias veces.

El palacio es uno de los mayores ejemplos de arquitectura mudéjar, estilo arquitectónico que se desarrolló durante el reino cristiano de España.

Posteriormente, como ya se mencionó, se realizaron cambios en el estilo gótico.

El Alcázar se divide en tres secciones: el Patio de las Doncellas, los Baños de doña María de Padilla y la Casa de Contratación. Las tres secciones forman el Palacio Real Alcázar.



★ LA LENGUA

En Sevilla se habla **español**, aunque con un acento bastante distintivo. De todas formas, si eres de otro país y no sabes bien el español, no te preocupes, la gente está muy acostumbrada a entender y ser comprendida sin problemas.

Poco después, Eleven (Once, en español), una niña aparentemente fugitiva y con poderes telequinéticos, se encuentra con Mike, Dustin y Lucas, amigos de Will, y los ayuda en la búsqueda del mismo.



LUCIFER

La serie gira en torno a Lucifer Morningstar, el Diablo, que abandona el Infierno por Los Ángeles, donde dirige su propio club nocturno y se convierte en consultor del LAPD. La filmación tuvo lugar principalmente en Vancouver, Columbia Británica, antes de que la producción se trasladara por completo a Los Ángeles, California, a partir de la tercera temporada. La primera temporada recibió reseñas mixtas de los críticos, aunque las temporadas posteriores fueron mejor calificadas; muchos críticos elogiaron particularmente el desempeño de Ellis.


